Clinical Attire Guidelines

Scrub Tops and Scrub Pants

- Each clinical discipline has one designated color of scrubs.
- It is highly recommended that scrub tops and pants are from the same vendor.
- Scrub tops, scrub pants, and scrub jackets must be the same color.
- CHI Health logo is not required on scrub tops, but is highly encouraged.
- Personalization, such as employee name and credentials, may be placed on the upper right chest area of the scrub top in white.

- Shirts worn under scrub tops:
 - May be short or long sleeved.
 - Color must match the scrub color OR be black, gray or white.
 - Must be a solid color with no patterns or prints.

Shoes and Socks

- Any style of shoe is permitted as long as they are closed-toe and meet clinical department guidelines.
- Any style of socks/nylons are permitted.

General Information

 Employees who work in more than one discipline should wear the scrub color of the discipline they are working for the day.
